



Folding Beach Ashtray



Traditional butts are made of “synthetic polymer cellulose acetate” and never degrade, only breaking apart after roughly 5 years. Birds and marine animals can mistake cigarette butts for food. Animals have been found with large quantities of butts in their stomachs. Toxins enter the food chain and wreak havoc with fish, birds and mammals. Yet within an hour of contact with water, cigarette butts can begin leaching chemicals such as cadmium, lead and arsenic into the marine environment.

- Designed to be transported easily (portable) and stored in flat way (folding).
- Attached to the beach to prevent the wind to blow the Ashtray away.
- It is a convenient way for smokers to remove their cigarette butts from the beach and can be easily emptied into a litter bin.
- Sponsorship in the form of advertising can be printed on the Beach Ashtray “SAVE SEA”.
- It can be cleaned after its use and stored again for the next time.
- Has long life span, designed to be completed safe for children.
- Not affected by salt water.
